

Make tax time easier by signing up for electronic tax documents! It's convenient, secure, and available in just a few steps. Keep in mind, signing up for e-Statements doesn't automatically include tax forms, so be sure to select electronic delivery for "Tax."

#### How to Get Started:

Log in to your Online Banking or Mobile App and click "e-Statements" in the Main Menu.

*If you haven't signed up for e-Statements:* Follow the prompts to set up your profile.

If you're already signed up for e-Statements: Check your Document Delivery Method preference under "My Profile" to verify that you've selected "electronic" as your delivery method for "Tax" documents.

Once you've signed up, you can view your <u>future</u> electronic tax documents on the homepage under eTax Forms.

Note: No 1099-INT or 1098 will be generated if your dividend amount is under \$10. Check your December statement for your total dividends.
